



## Millarville Community Church

The Millarville Community Church congregation was founded in 1982 from adult Bible study groups. The first Sunday service wasn't held until Sept. 1983 in the Millarville Community Library with services later held in the school auditorium and Ranchers Hall.

In 2003 a piece of land on Highway 549, PTN SE-13-21-03-W5M, was donated and a temporary building was moved onto the land the following year.

In 2005 the congregation had started a 5 year plan to build on this 2 hectare piece of land. However, a 5,387 square foot church building was sitting empty along MacLeod Trail in Calgary and needed to be demolished or relocated. The timing was perfect and the price was right - \$1.00. The large building was cut into 3 sections and the long slow move began at

midnight on Jan. 21st. arriving at its Millarville location at noon on the 22nd. The land had been prepared for its arrival but the building required many hours of volunteers doing repairs and set up in order for it to be useable, the first service was held in the building in July 2006.

The non-denominational congregation bases their worship on Gods written word, the Bible. Over the years they have enjoyed fellowship with Sunday services, weekly Bible studies, youth activities, breakfasts, teas and much more.
